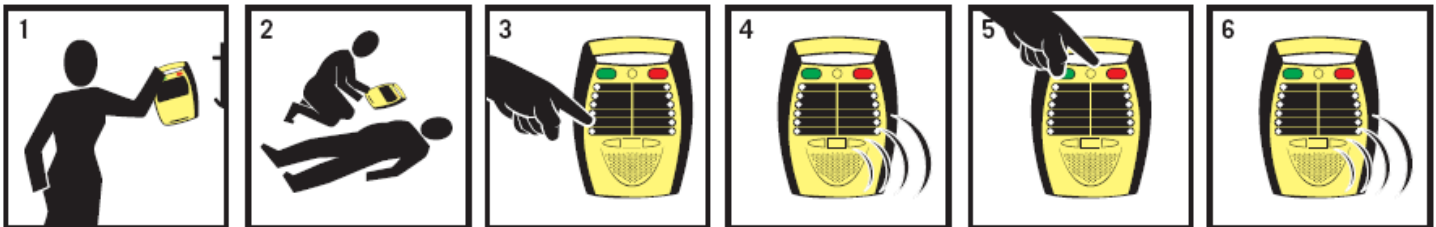

In a medical emergency, call 9-1-1, then use SafetyMate to treat victim until professional help arrives.



1 Remove SafetyMate from Charging Cradle.

2 For ease of use, place SafetyMate close to victim.

3 Press appropriate Emergency Information Button.

4 SafetyMate will provide verbal instructions followed by a question.

5 Respond to the question by pressing Yes or No.

6 Follow verbal instructions.
